 - What do you do to withstand it when you are the target?
- Read Psalm 139:1-12
 - These verses paint a picture of God's Spirit being inescapable for you. Does this give you comfort or is it an oppressive thought for you? Why or why not?
 - What does this characteristic of God teach us about his desire for our presence?
 - Why do you think God wants to be in our midst so ferociously?
- Read Psalm 139:13-18
 - How do you feel about possessions that were made for you by someone vs. something you bought at the store?
 - What makes those items more sentimental to people?
 - How do you apply this thought to God after reading this passage?
 - Respond to this statement: Agree or Disagree? "One of the most incredible aspects of the greatness of humanity is that it was created by God with great care and intricacy."
