  - In what ways does God need to be legitimized in our society? How do we do that and for what purpose?
- Read Isaiah 40:27-31
  - In your own words describe the complaint of Israel.
  - What are some modern day complaints you've heard that sound like what Isaiah is addressing in this passage?
  - How do you think Isaiah is answering that in the rest of the passage?
  - How does this passage encourage you?
- Pastor Harold taught us on Sunday that we need to adopt a "self-cancel culture". To cancel self plans in favor of God's plans for us.
  - Why do you think God would want you to let go of your plans for your life? Are your plans for yourself bad?
  - What plans have you had to exchange for God's plans? How did that work out for you?
