



# GOD OF CREATION

## Immensity

- What is something that stuck out to you from last Sunday's teaching?
- Circle Time: Think about when you were a small child... describe a moment that your parents felt like they were really BIG compared to you.
  - What do you think it was that made them feel so big compared to you?
  - When in your life did their "bigness" start to fade?
  - Why do you think being "big" is so important for a small child?
  - Have you ever felt small as an adult? Describe the situation.
- Read Psalm 19:1-6
  - What are "the heavens" that the Psalmist refers to in v.1?
    - Where else in Scripture have you heard that term? Does that provide any context for your group's discussion?
    - In Gen 1:1 the heavens are the first thing mentioned in the order of God's creation. "In the beginning He created the heavens and the earth." Why do you think the rest of the chapter focuses on the creation of the earth, but there are no details about the creation of the heavens or really even what they are?
  - What do you think the Psalmist is trying to teach us about God in Psalm 19?
  - In v. 3-4 it speaks about a message being proclaimed to all of God's creation without using words... In what ways have you heard this message through experiencing God's creation? What is the knowledge they reveal?
  - Compare and contrast a tent vs. a house
  - The psalmist gives us this word picture of God, in His immensity, building a small shelter for us that shades us, protects us, and gives us a place to rest. How does this thought lend to the idea of God's "bigness"?
- What does the temporary nature of "tent" teach us about God's plan for humanity?
- What does all of this mean for how we live our lives today?
