 - Notice the verbs in 6:6-8 (I will bring... I will free... I will redeem... I will take... I will be your God... I will give) What do these phrases tell you about the meaning of the Lords name?
- Why do you think God allowed things to get worse for Israel?
 - How does Israel's response to the new revelation from God (6:9) compare with the people's previous one (4:31) Do you think this is justifiable? Why or why not?
 - What is the purpose of God's plan concerning Pharaoh?
 - To what does Moses ascribe the failure of his mission to?
- Read Exodus 6:13-30
 - What is important to note about the genealogy?
 - How does the genealogy legitimize the call and commission of Moses and Aaron?
 - What in our study of 5-6 was personally significant to you?
