- Read Numbers 13:1-33
 - What stands out to you in this passage?
 - What is significant about the fact that they call the inhabitants *Nephilim*?
 - Does anyone know who the Nephilim were? *Genesis 6:4*
 - Do you believe that the scouts actually saw Nephilim? Why or why not? *Genesis 6 is before the flood event. Genesis 7 tells us that all mankind were wiped from the face of the earth. This would certainly include the Nephilim.*
 - So, if they didn't actually see Nephilim then why did they call the people there Nephilim? Why make the statement that we are grasshoppers compared to them?
 - What are some ways that society makes Giants out problems that are giant sized? Have you ever let your mind make something bigger than it really is?
- Read 1 Samuel 17
 - What are the differences between David and Goliath that make them an antithesis of each other?
 - Compare and contrast David's understanding of the situation and Saul's understanding of the situation.
 - What specific information did Saul rely on to make his decision to not confront Goliath? What information motivated David to confront Goliath?
- In his teaching, Pastor Dave mentioned that for the Israelites, the giants are in their own perspective and not in reality. How have you been witness to this truth in your life?
- What are some steps you take to allow God's perspective be your perspective?
