- Read Romans 3:1-8
 - What do you think Paul mean by the word “unfaithful” in v.3?
 - What do you think Paul means in vs. 8? Do people really say that? What is another way to say it so it makes more sense?
 - How do the concepts in v. 1-8 apply to us?
- Read Romans 3:9-20
 - Now Paul is saying that Jews don’t have an advantage. Why do you think he keeps flip flopping about this?
 - What do you think Paul is trying to communicate by quoting various Psalms concerning humanity’s sin?
 - If the Law reveals our sin what does this mean for the level of accountability that the Jews will face
- Read Romans 3:21-26
 - Unpack as a group what the words atonement and justification mean.
 - What do you think Paul means when he says that God had left the sins committed beforehand go unpunished?
- Read Romans 3:27-31
 - How can Paul say that the uncircumcised and the circumcised are saved by faith and at the same time say that our faith upholds the law when the law is to be circumcised?
 - How do we apply this stuff to our lives?
