# Above & Beyond (update as of September 30)

Good Shepherd's Above & Beyond (A&B) program ended the fiscal year with only 2 funds not fully funded. The status of the two funds with remaining balances is: A&B HVAC Wishlist: \$200,000; Balance Remaining: \$165,000 | A&B Preschool Expansion Wishlist: \$68,000; Balance Remaining: \$19,769 \*

\*The preschool was also awarded a grant in the amount of \$2,500 from the Southeastern District (a group of Lutheran churches in the southeastern part of the country) to be used specifically for online marketing (Facebook, Google, etc).

Hypothermia Shelter Meals – SIGNUP OPEN! An opportunity to serve through supporting the hypothermia shelter meals program is fast approaching! Every Wednesday from the beginning of December through the end of March (17 weeks), we prepare, provide, and serve hot meals for 40 guests. Would you like to know what it is like to prepare food for the Hypothermia Prevention Program? The best way to think about preparing the food is to consider what you would bring if this were a picnic. You need to provide food in disposable containers and include any needed (sturdy) plates, bowls, cups, napkins, eating utensils. One consideration is that the clients often don't have a full set of teeth - shredded or ground meat is preferable to chunks of meat. The same is true about the fruit. This year the need is much greater as they are serving about 70 people. We will be helping with that number by providing a minimum of 40 meals. Serving in person is also back this year! South Lakes Food Pantry – continues to serve the community! Since the beginning they have distributed more than TWO MILLION POUNDS of food & toiletries to our neighbors in need. What a significant difference you've made in the community with your support of this incredible ministry. We are averaging well over 7,000 pounds (3 ½ tons) of food to families and students in need each week.
