Hypothermia Shelter Meals – Signup today, openings on January 15. An opportunity to serve through supporting the hypothermia shelter meals program is fast approaching! Every Wednesday through the end of March (17 weeks), we prepare, provide, and serve hot meals for 40 guests. Would you like to know what it is like to prepare food for the Hypothermia Prevention Program? The best way to think about preparing the food is to consider what you would bring if this were a picnic. You need to provide food in disposable containers and include any needed (sturdy) plates, bowls, cups, napkins, eating utensils. One consideration is that the clients

often don't have a full set of teeth - shredded or ground meat is preferable to chunks of meat. The same is true about the fruit. This year the need is much greater as they are serving about 70 people. **We will be helping with that number by providing a minimum of 40 meals**. Serving in person is also back this year! South Lakes Food Pantry – continues to serve the community! Since the beginning they have distributed more than TWO MILLION POUNDS of food & toiletries to our neighbors in need. What a significant difference you've made in the community with your support of this incredible ministry. We are averaging well over 7,000 pounds (3 ½ tons) of food to families and students in need each week. 

Columbarium garden- deadline to give December 31!

The deadline to give for the columbarium garden is fast approaching. We have a commitment to fund \$60,000 of the project's cost, but only if an additional \$40,000 is committed before Tuesday, December 31. This \$40,000 can come from presales of niches and/or donations to the Above & Beyond (A&B) fund. The columbarium garden, once constructed, would be located to the right of the entry drive as one enters the campus. It will contain between 48 and 72 individual niches in two or three 5-foot by 9-foot granite units. Each of the niches can hold two (2) urns, so one niche could accommodate both a husband and wife, grandparents, etc. Funds from pre-sales of niches as well as donations will be placed in a restricted account. If sufficient funding for the project has not been achieved by December 31, 2025, funds can be refunded or applied to other uses at Good Shepherd. If the \$100,000 goal is met, solicitation of bids for construction will begin immediately



with project completion anticipated before the close of 2025. Questions and comments can be directed to Georgia Thorstenson (georgia@gslcva.org).
