Hypothermia Shelter Meals – SIGNUP OPEN! An opportunity to serve through supporting the hypothermia shelter meals program is fast approaching! Every Wednesday from the beginning of December through the end of March (17 weeks), we prepare, provide, and serve hot meals for 40 guests. Would you like to know what it is like to prepare food for the Hypothermia Prevention Program? The best way to think about preparing the food is to consider what you would bring if this were an outdoor gathering. You need to provide food in disposable containers and include any needed (sturdy) plates, bowls, cups, napkins, eating utensils. One consideration is that the clients often don't have a full set of teeth - shredded or ground meat is preferable to chunks of meat. The same is true about the fruit. This year the need is much greater as they are serving about 80 people. We will be helping with that number by providing a minimum of 40 meals. Serving in person is also back this year but you still have the option to drop off the meals! Volunteers must be at least 18 years old to serve in the shelter. ### **SOUTH LAKES FOOD PANTRY - Continues to Serve the Community!**

The Food Pantry has distributed more than **TWO MILLION NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND POUNDS** of food and toiletries to our neighbors in need. Needs are on the rise. We are averaging well over **7,000 pounds (3½ tons) of food to families and students in need each week**.
