Lent 2025: "The Hand of the Lord"

Worship services during Lent this year will explore the theme "The Hand of the Lord."



Hands are amazing instruments. They can be used to heal or hurt, work or wreck, build or break, seize or surrender. Hands are central to the ways we interact with the world and are symbols of power, control, craftsmanship, and possession.

Hands are mentioned throughout the Bible. In the Old Testament, we find more than two hundred references to the Lord's hand being active in creation, power, control over happenings of the world, judgment, and salvation.

In the New Testament, the "hand of the Lord" takes on literal meaning: The hand of the Lord comes to us in Jesus. Join us each Wednesday during Lent for midweek services as we consider hands: the hand of the Lord; Jesus' real hands; and our own hands, restored as useful instruments of witness, service, and praise.
