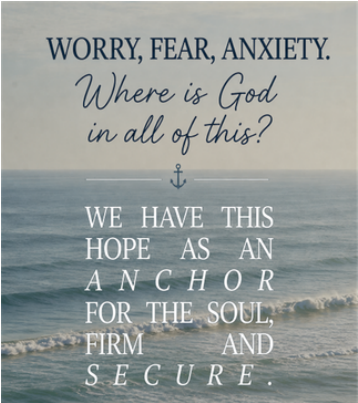
Women's Retreat (Registration Reminder)
