Lesson Focus
We belong to God.



If you are using the Semi-Continuous version of the Revised Common Lectionary (ELCIC, Episcopal Church USA, Anglican Church of Canada, PCUSA, United Methodist Church, United Church of Christ), the lesson for Lectionary 29 is A New Covenant (Jeremiah 31:27-34). # Gather (10 minutes)

### Center Time

You may choose to set up all or some of these learning centers for kids to play in as they arrive in your classroom. Have helpers in each center to help kids with the activities. Kids can stay in one center or travel to more than one.

When all kids have arrived and have had time to participate in at least one center, say the following rhyme:

## 1-2-3-4 Come on! Let's sit on the floor! 5-6-7-8 Pick up your things and don't be late! It's Circle Time!

Repeat until all the kids hear and start cleaning up.

#### I Belong to God Button

Use a paper cutter to cut the paper into triangles large enough to accommodate the rectangle lesson sticker, about 3 inches (8 cm) on a side. Set out other art items. Make a sample. Let kids put the "I belong to God" stickers on their triangles. Use the star and heart stickers and markers to decorate the buttons. Use double stick tape to attach buttons to kids' clothing.

## **Stick Together**

Set the magnets and metal items on a flat surface. Let the kids experiment with the things you brought and other items in the classroom.

#### **Coloring Center**

Have coloring supplies and copies of the Spark Coloring Page available at a table for the kids to color. Be sure to help them put their names on their papers.

### Circle Time

Use the marker to write each kid's name on a pumpkin seed. We belong to God. God knows us by name. I have written our names on pumpkin seeds. When you put your pumpkin seed in the cup, we'll say, "Welcome [Name]. You belong to **God."** Who wants to go first? Go around until all have been welcomed.

Hold up the leaflet. Let's look at our leaflet to find out about the church season. I see a green tree. The green tree tells us it is Pentecost, the season of growing. From the time we are as little as a pumpkin seed to the time we grow big, big, big like a tree, we belong to God.

Pick up the magnets. Look at these magnets. They stick together don't they? They belong together, just like we belong with God. God's promises are stronger than the strongest magnet. God promises that we will always belong to God!

## Prayer Time

I'm going to add this piece of ribbon to our buttons to remind us that we belong to God. God always loves us. Tape a piece of ribbon to everyone's button. Let's touch our ribbon while we pray and thank God for taking care of us.

# Open the Bible (15 minutes)

# A New Covenant Storytelling

Our story today is about promises and God's love. God had a message for the people. The message was about love. God shared the message with Jeremiah and told him to tell everyone. Open your Spark Story Bible to page 176. Here is a picture of Jeremiah when he was just a boy. Turn to page 179. Here is Jeremiah when he is a grown-up. He is sharing a message from God with the people. Let's listen to the story of Jeremiah.

Jeremiah was one of God's prophets. When God had a message for the people, God told Jeremiah what to say, and Jeremiah told the people. Once, when God's people were in trouble and about to be sent away from their home, God had a message for them. Jeremiah told the people what God said.

"I'm about to make a new promise to my people," God said. "My people have forgotten that I am their God. But I have not forgotten my people."

"Jeremiah, tell my people that I still love them. Tell them that I will make a new promise to them soon. I will change them so they know how much I love them. They can't change themselves, but I can do it for them—and I will!" said God.

"I will write my new promise on their hearts! Everyone will know how much I love them and they will want to do the right thing when I'm done changing them. I will be their God and they will be my people—that's the promise. They won't even have to teach each other about me—they'll just know.

"Tell them, Jeremiah!" said God. "Tell everyone that I love them and I forgive them. Tell my people that things will soon change and I will be with them no matter what!"

**How long will we belong to God?** (forever) **Where does God write the new promise?** (on our hearts) Why do you think we forget about God?

## Belonging

Pass each kid a stuffed animal. We belong to God. Belonging to God means that God takes care of us. When pets and other animals belong to us, it is our responsibility to take care of them. We're going to go around the circle. When it is your turn, show us or tell us something you would do to take care of your animal. Who wants to go first? As each kid shares something, have all the kids act out what they suggest. Continue until everyone has had a chance to share something. Be ready to prompt kids who need help. It's okay if actions are repeated.

## A Special Message

Cut the ribbon into 12 inch (30 cm) pieces. Pass out the leaflets and ribbons. Look at the picture on the leaflet. The people are hearing a message that God sent. God told Jeremiah the message. God promised to love and care for us always. God wants us to remember the message. Look at the happy people. They are happy to hear a message from God. They are happy that Jeremiah shares good news. We are going to roll our leaflets up to look like a special message. Show the kids how to roll their leaflets. Later, we will use this ribbon to tie our leaflets so we can take our special messages home.

# Activate Faith (15 minutes)

## I Belong to . . .

Let's turn our leaflets over. Each of the things on one side of the page belongs to something on the other. The first thing is a mouse. What does the mouse belong to? (computer) Let's draw a line from the mouse to the computer. Where does the puppy belong? (boy or girl) Draw a line connecting the kid and the puppy. And who needs a carrot? The snowman, that's right! The carrot belongs to the snowman, just like we belong to God.

## Follow God's Message

God had a message for the people. God gave the message to Jeremiah and told Jeremiah to tell everyone. We have three stickers that will help us figure out the message. Put the stickers on the message where they match. Let's put the red sticker on first. Everyone grab the red sticker. Put it on the red part of the leaflet. Now put on the yellow sticker and then the blue sticker. Our message says, "You belong to me! Love God" That is a very good message. Let's tie our leaflets up to look like a message. Help kids tie ribbons around their leaflets.

## Belong Together

Let's sit in a circle. Give each kid one half of a pair of socks. Hold your socks behind your backs. Leave the other socks in the center of the circle. We're going to take turns finding socks that belong together. When it is your turn, you may choose a sock from the center of the circle. Go around the outside of the circle until you find someone who has the sock that matches yours. Then you can both put a sock on your hand and share a high five. Just like the socks that belong together, we belong to God!

# Send (5 minutes)

# Good-bye Time

Sit in a circle and thank the kids for coming. Hold up the leaflet, review the Bible story, and ask the kids what they enjoyed about the day.

#### Before we go, let's share a song.

Sing this song to the tune of "Hot Cross Buns."

Time to go. Time to go.
We've had fun, but now it's over.
Time to go.

Dads are here. Moms are here. Grandmas, grandpas, sisters, brothers. Give a cheer!
