# Prayer requests - a note from Pastor Johann

Dear prayer warriors - We will now only post prayer requests for three weeks. After three weeks, requests will need to be updated to remain on the prayer chain. In the quick-moving pandemic, we need to be more up-to-date and nimbler. It is challenging to keep requests updated, especially because some folks aren't able to update us on their requests in a timely fashion, and the staff has to deal with privacy issues in asking for updates, keeping us from properly updating the prayer requests, beyond three weeks, with accuracy and in a timely fashion. Holding on to prayer requests, worded more than two weeks old can create confusion, and in fact, has been creating some confusion for members of our prayer chain, already. We will keep trying to hunt down updates from requestors as best as we can, but will only keep un-updated requests for three weeks

North County Hypothermia Shelter Meals. Good Shepherd will once again be supporting the Fairfax County hypothermia shelter every Wednesday, December through March. COVID-19 restrictions have changed due to a rise in COVID-19 infections – volunteers will no longer be allowed to serve meals at this time. Cornerstones is hopeful that this change is temporary. Meals should be delivered between 5:30 p.m. and 5:45 p.m. to the Hypothermia Shelter, located in the North County Human Services Building, 1850 Cameron Glen Drive in Reston, just ¼ mile from the Embry Rucker Shelter. Food should be delivered hot and in disposable containers, along with all the napkins, plates, cups, and plastic utensils needed for the evening. Restaurant food deliveries are also welcome!
