What does it mean to be an Elder? What does it mean to be a Deacon? What characteristics are we looking for when we call people to this work in the church? What are the responsibilities that go with each position?

What are the Book of Order requirements/recommendations for each office and for Nominating Committees?

How does an effective Nominating Committee do its work? How do we move from “filling slots” to discerning who is called to serve?
