- God weaves our redemption and healing in silence in the background (that moment was building) 1.
- 2. Something that could have taken years of counselling or possibly never been revealed(power encounter)
- 3. Set free from torment in an instance in a sudden growth event

В. Practically speaking- Spiritual growth happens by way of both process and an event.

- 1. In process we develop as we mature over time as we experience grace and truth –
 - Much like a tree developing fruit / or an infant needing milk / or more mature needing meat a)
 - This type of growth happens in stages. Continues offer 2nd coming christian b)

1 Jn 2:12-13 I am writing to you, little children, because your sins have been forgiven you for His name's sake. 13 I am writing to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because you have overcome the evil one.



- 2. In the "event" – the Lord accelerates our growth by means of an "Aha – Eureka – Power Point
 - a) These occur when we interact with objective markers – Core Christian truths that move us.

Example – The James F. Engels scale (process or persuasion evangelism), "stages in intellect (from a little to a lot) and attitudes (from hostile to responsive) that people go through in Christian conversion. There is always someone in our culture on the verge of converting. Openness to the gospel can be measured based on this process of intellect and attitude toward the Gospel. Wimber taught "Power Evangelism" - clear presentation of the Gospel, and a demonstration of the Kingdom

Fransition- Consider Pauls" Event growth experience, when He meets Jesus on the road to Damascus. His interaction with Jesus significantly thrusted His spiritual maturity forward

Read Acts 9:1-19 (A little background on Paul acts 7)

C. Suddenly- Saul's personal agenda was interrupted by interaction with Holy Spirits divine agenda

- Eks ife- naze/ communicates 2 primary concepts
 - 1) Eks- is the idea of a Kairos and Chronos moment combined- Its an event that is made up of "right time, place and cause"
 - Ife-knee-dee-ahs unexpected/interruption where God Shines light/revelation in a moment of time.
 - 3) Paul's "Suddenness revelation" was like the putting on of a new garment

D. Spiritual growth is Gods intentional plan

- 1. This "suddenness event" gripped Paul and revealed His purpose and calling in moments.
- 2. A powerful encounter with Jesus can move us beyond a rational lengthy process.
- 3. These events if embraced will move us into a place of victory, freedom, purpose and calling

Paul turned on like a light - and was forever set on a path toward Spiritual Growth.

III. How does Pauls suddenness event relate to me?


Phil 1:6 For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.
