Scripture Focus: Nehemiah 9–11

Theme: Confession, Covenant, and Commitment in Community

Scripture Focus:

our identity

- -"You have been just in all that has come upon us... yet we have acted wickedly." Nehemiah 9:33
- -"We join with their brothers... and enter into a curse and an oath to walk in God's law." Nehemiah 10:29
- -"The people blessed all the men who willingly offered to live in Jerusalem." Nehemiah 11:2

Reflection:

1. Confession (Nehemiah 9)

- · What stands out to you in the people's prayer of confession?
- How does remembering God's faithfulness shape the way we repent today?

2. Covenant Renewal (Nehemiah 10)

- Why do you think the people made such specific commitments (Sabbath, temple support, purity)?
- What spiritual practices help you stay faithful to your commitments?

3. Costly Commitment (Nehemiah 11)

- What does it mean to "move in" to the work God is doing, even when it's uncomfortable?
- Who are the quiet heroes in your life or church who model this kind of faithfulness?

Prayer Prompts

- · Confess areas where you've drifted from God's ways.
- Thank God for His mercy across your personal and communal story.
- Ask for courage to renew your commitments and serve where He's calling you

Practical Application:

- Write your own "confession and covenant" prayer this week naming both your failures and God's faithfulness.
- Identify one area of spiritual commitment (worship, giving, Sabbath, service) where you can take a next step.
- Encourage someone who's quietly serving—bless them as the people did in Nehemiah 11:2.
