★ ABOUT

Jonathan was King David's best friend when they were young men.

Jonathan appears in 1 Samuel, especially chapters 13-14, 18-20, and 23.

★ JONATHAN'S TRAITS

- LOYAL:** Jonathan stayed true to his friend David even when it put him at odds with his father, King Saul. (1 Samuel 18:3)
- BRAVE:** He faced the Philistines with just his armor-bearer, showing courage rooted in faith. (1 Samuel 14:6)
- SELFLESS:** Jonathan gave David his royal robe and weapons, showing he was willing to give up his claim to the throne. (1 Samuel 18:4)
- ENCOURAGING:** He went to David in the wilderness and helped him find strength in God. (1 Samuel 23:16)
- FAITHFUL:** He remained faithful to God's plan, even when it meant stepping aside for David. (1 Samuel 20:13)

★ WHAT WE CAN LEARN FROM JONATHAN

- True friendship is selfless:** Jonathan loved David as himself and celebrated his success, even when it meant giving up his own future throne.
- Bravery comes from trusting God:** Jonathan stepped out in faith during battles and believed God could save, whether by many or few.
- Standing for what's right takes courage:** He stood up to his father Saul to protect David, showing loyalty to God over family pressure.
- God values loyalty and integrity:** Jonathan didn't seek fame, but his quiet faithfulness shines throughout Scripture.
