BIBLE CHARACTER SPOTLIGHT: RUTH

★ ABOUT

Ruth was a Moabite woman who chose to stay with her Israelite mother-in-law, Naomi, after both of their husbands died. Instead of returning to her own people, Ruth committed herself to Naomi and to the God of Israel. God honored Ruth's faithfulness by providing for her through Boaz, whom she later married. Ruth became the great-grandmother of King David and part of the family line of Jesus.



★ BIBLE VERSES

Ruth's story is found in the Book of Ruth 1-4. Her genealogy references are found in Matthew 1:5 and Luke 3:32

★ RUTH'S TRAITS

- **FAITHFUL:** She remained loyal to Naomi even when life was uncertain (Ruth 1:16-17)
- **LOVING:** She showed deep, sacrificial love through her actions, not just words (Ruth 1:8)
- **HARD-WORKING:** She diligently worked in the fields to provide for herself and Naomi (Ruth 2:2, 7)
- **HUMBLE: She recognized kindness and did not assume she was owed anything (Ruth 2:10)**
- **TRUSTING:** She stepped into a new land and faith with confidence in God's provision (Ruth 1:16)

★ WHAT WE CAN LEARN FROM RUTH

- **Faithfulness matters, even in small choices:** God uses everyday obedience for His greater plans.
- **God welcomes outsiders:** Ruth reminds us that God's love and purposes are for all people.
- **Hard work honors God:** Doing our best, even in difficult seasons, is noticed by Him.
- **Kindness can change lives:** Ruth's kindness to Naomi and Boaz's kindness to Ruth both reflect God's care.
- **God is always at work behind the scenes:** Even when life feels ordinary or hard, God is writing a bigger story.
