# MONTHLY DEVOTIONAL

## Making Room for Jesus

Our lives can get very full—full of school, chores, hobbies, activities, and even worries. Our hearts can feel the same way—crowded with thoughts, emotions, and distractions. But in the middle of all that, Jesus invites us to make space for Him. “He must become greater; I must become less” (John 3:30, NIV) is a simple reminder that Jesus should be the most important part of our lives, not just something we squeeze in when there’s time.

This means choosing to put Jesus first. That might look like starting your day with a prayer before anything else. It might mean turning off a show to spend time reading your Bible. It might even mean letting go of bad attitudes like complaining or jealousy so that your heart has space to grow in love, peace, and kindness.

When we make room for Jesus, amazing things happen. He fills our hearts with joy that lasts longer than any toy or game. He brings peace when we feel overwhelmed. He helps us forgive when we’re hurt, and love others when it’s hard. Jesus doesn’t want just a little corner of our lives. He wants to be at the center! And when we give Him that space, everything else begins to fall into place in a healthier, more peaceful way.
