## Let Your Light Shine: Sharing Your Faith with Others

A brand-new year is like a fresh page—clean, bright, and full of chances to follow Jesus in new ways. As we step into January, we can remember that each day gives us another opportunity to show God’s love to the people around us. We don’t have to be famous or loud to make a difference. Jesus says that when we live in a way that honors Him, it’s like turning on a light in a dark room!

The Bible tells us, “Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.” (Matthew 5:16)
