Love That Acts

Love is more than words – it is shown through our actions. Jesus showed His love by serving and giving His life for us, and we can follow His example by loving others in real, practical ways.

It's easy to say, "I love you," but actions prove it. If you love someone, do something for them that is not easy to do. If you love your parents, jump up to do what they ask when they ask it. If you love a friend, let them have their way at least half the time, even if you want something else.

The Bible tells us, "Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth." (1 John 3:18).

Jesus is our greatest example of love in action. He healed the sick when he could have been hanging out with friends. He calmed a storm when his friends got scared. He loved others more than Himself because He knew: If he shared God's love throughout his life, others would love God, too. Then they would all be together in happiness.
