1. I SPEAK WITH INTEGRITY.

Proverbs 17:7 (MSG) We don't expect eloquence from fools, nor do we expect lies from our leaders.

Proverbs 25:14 (CEV) Broken promises are worse than rain clouds that don't bring rain.

Proverbs 10:9 People with integrity walk safely, but those who follow crooked paths will be exposed.

2. I SERVE WITH INTENSITY

Proverbs 14:22b if you plan to do good, you will receive unfailing love and faithfulness.

Proverbs 11:27 (CEV) Try hard to do right, and you will win friends;

3. I SHARE WITH GENEROSITY

Psalm 112:9 (CEV) They will always be remembered and greatly praised, because they were kind and freely gave to the poor.

Prov 11:25 The generous will prosper; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed.
