## **Dress Code**

What type of clothing do I wear on the trip?

## Ladies and Girls:

- For daytime, comfortable shorts or pants and T-shirts, tennis shoes, or sturdy sandals. Flip-flops are not recommended for village work
- For evening church services, a casual dress or skirt
- Bathing suits must be one-piece for showering on the back of the boat or a full-coverage tankini.
- Shorts should be at least mid-thigh length. Hiking shorts are usually longer if you have trouble finding long shorts.
- Low-cut tops, tank tops, tight-fitting tops, or tops with spaghetti straps are not appropriate. Tops or T-shirts must cover the entire midriff area, no matter what position you are in (bending over or reaching up)
- Please refrain from wearing oversized T-shirts with shorts that are too short. It looks like you do not have shorts on.
- Bring flip-flops to wear on the boat. These are "boat shoes" and the other is "village shoes"

## Men and Boys:

- For daytime, comfortable shorts or pants and T-shirts, tennis shoes or sturdy sandals. Flip-flops are not recommended for village work
- For evening church services, pants or dress shorts
- A shirt must be worn at all times
- Shorts should be mid-thigh length or longer
- A swimsuit must be worn for showering on the back of the boat
- Bring flip-flops to wear on the boat. These are "boat shoes" and the other is "village shoes"
