

Dress Code

What to Wear on the Trip

Ladies and Girls

- **Daytime Attire:** Choose comfortable shorts or pants paired with T-shirts. Opt for tennis shoes or sturdy sandals, as flip-flops are not recommended for village work.
- **Evening Church Services:** Wear a casual dress or skirt.
- **Bathing Suits:** A one-piece swimsuit or a full-coverage tankini is required for showering on the back of the boat.
- **Shorts:** Should be at least mid-thigh length. Consider longer hiking shorts.
- **Tops:** Avoid low-cut, tank tops, tight-fitting tops, and spaghetti straps. Tops or T-shirts should adequately cover the entire midriff, even when bending over or reaching up.
- **Oversized T-Shirts:** Paired with shorts that are too short can give the appearance of not wearing shorts. Please avoid this combination.
- **Footwear on the Boat:** Bring flip-flops to wear as “boat shoes.” Different footwear is advised for village activities.

Men and Boys

- **Daytime Attire:** Opt for comfortable shorts or pants with T-shirts. Choose tennis shoes or sturdy sandals instead of flip-flops for village work.
- **Evening Church Services:** Pants or dress shorts are appropriate.
- **Shirts:** Must be worn at all times.
- **Shorts:** Should be mid-thigh length or longer.
- **Swimsuit:** Required for showering on the back of the boat.
- **Footwear on the Boat:** Bring flip-flops for use as “boat shoes.” Different footwear should be used for village activities.

Please note, Christians in Brazil tend to dress conservatively. We aim to respect their cultural norms through our attire and actions

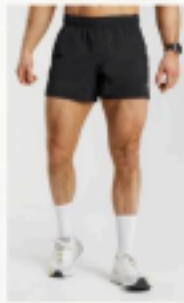
