## ***Under His Mighty Protection***

Sometimes we’re unaware of the dangers that might befall us. A near accident, a close call, or even a scam email can leave us shaken. As followers of Christ, we trust that we are under God’s mighty protection. We know that all we need to do is ask.

Yet there are moments when we forget to ask. Times when we’re not in constant communication with our Creator, or when our faith wavers for one reason or another. Even then—when we are unaware or unprepared—God’s protection never leaves us.
