Consistory Meeting Summary

October 8, 2024

Devotions and prayer were offered by Mike Bosscher entitled Wait Until You Get To The Corner, Lamentations 3: 21-26, we are called to be Holy in our waiting on The Lord.

A summary of the Elders Meeting was provided to the deacons.

Financial Report: The deacons gave a report of the current financial status, the Third Quarter Financial Report, will be shared in the bulletin on October 13th. A discussion followed regarding the Giving Baskets and how to best announce offering and the basket location.

Several shared praises and testimonials of seeing God at work in their lives and in the lives of our Rehoboth family. Approximately 30, 9-12th graders have recently committed their lives to Christ.
