1/21/26: Letha McGraw's husband, **Doug McGraw**, is unable to have a lithotripsy procedure; so he had surgery on 1/22, to remove a very large kidney stone. Please pray for Doug's recovery! **UPDATE 1/26**: PRAISE! Doug is doing very well after surgery! **UPDATE 1/29**: Doug has been in the ICU unit at Munson Cadillac since Wednesday morning. He has a severe kidney, bladder and blood infection. Pray his fever will subside and that he will have complete healing. **UPDATE 1/31**: Doug has now developed pneumonia with a continued high fever. **UPDATE 2/4**: Doug is home and is very weak and tired and he has several follow-up appointments with doctors to determine what to do next. Pray that he may gain in strength and that Letha will be able to take care of him.

1/27/26: **Colter Bailey**, nephew to Krisann DeZeeuw, has received his 2nd Stem Cell transplant. The chemo prior to stem cell rescue was very harsh this time and cause terrible Mucositis. He has been at DeVos now for 4 weeks. To come home, his bone marrow needs to continue to regenerate, he needs to start eating, drinking more, and being able to take oral medication! Please continue to pray for those specific things and keep lifting up Colter and family. **UPDATE 2/5**: On Friday, Feb 6 Colter will have his simulation for radiation treatments that will tentatively start on Tuesday, Feb 17. Afterwards, he will get discharged and come home after almost 6 weeks of being at Helen Devos! Please continue to pray for Colter's healing and that he continues to gain strength back!
