UPDATE 2/10: Doug McGraw was in the ER all day on 2/10. Doug has a kidney infection again, and he is very weak. He had a heart specialist appointment on 2/13 and they ask for prayers for his kidney infection to subside, his stamina to improve and a good appointment on Friday with his heart specialist. **UPDATE 2/10:** Doug had been discharged from the ER on the evening of 2/10 and is now home. Please continue to pray for him and recovery. **UPDATE 2/14:** The heart specialist says to remove the pacemaker lead from Doug's heart valve is way to risky. However, there has been success for others with medication. He has the new medication and will do labs in another week. Letha will contact us when she gets the results and get an update on how Doug is feeling. Hopefully, the urologist will remove the stent from Doug's kidney on Tuesday. He also has a follow-up with his family doctor that same day. Both Doug and Letha thank you for all the prayers! Please keep the prayers coming.

2/17/26: On 2/17 **Arlene Scholten** was in the garage helping with a few things. As she was coming up the stairs into the house, she missed the grab handle and fell onto the cement. An ambulance was called, and she was taken to the hospital in Cadillac for evaluation and care. **UPDATE 2/17:** After testing it was found that Arlene broke her right hip. **UPDATE 2/18:** Because Arlene is on blood thinners, she was unable to have her hip surgery on 2/17. However, they do plan on having her surgery on 2/19. We've been told that it's a pretty good-sized fracture so it will most likely be a lengthy journey ahead of her. Please continue to pray for Arlene. And pray for the doctor's guiding hand, that it is a successful surgery and that the recovery process is swift.

2/18/26: On 2/19 **Patti Bosscher** underwent wrist surgery to correct a chronically dislocated thumb. It was outpatient surgery in Grand Rapids. It carries a 12-week recovery time! Please pray for successful surgery and quick healing!

UPDATE 2/19: Colter Bailey, nephew to Krisann DeZeeuw, has started radiation treatments on his abdomen. He has 12 sessions to complete. Please pray for safe daily travels back and forth to Lemmen Holten in Grand Rapids. The biggest hurdle is keeping him happy prior to treatment; he cannot eat or drink 8 hours prior as he must be sedated. Please continue to pray for Colter and his entire family, they appreciate the prayers!
