-CONSISTORY MEETING SUMMARY-

May 13, 2025

The Meeting was called to order by Mike at 7:15 pm.

Devotions and prayer were offered by Mark, reading from the Sermon on the Mount, Matthew 6: 25-34; Do not worry about your life, that we need to lose our life to gain it, reminding us to always move right side up and forward, always putting His Kingdom first, closing by reading a prayer from the book, Diary of a Private Prayer by Dr. John Baillie.

Elders Meeting Report was given by Mike and all Elders present, the Communion and Town Hall meeting dates were reviewed.

Doug McLain, representative from the Security Team, was present to offer a proposal to the Consistory for consideration, after discussion, this will be placed on the June agenda.

Financial Report: The deacons provided the April updates to the financial status and the current spending plan. The deacons have approved a new synthesizer and a new computer for Jason (as the current equipment is no longer functional and the money is available within the spending plan). An open discussion regarding the 2025/2026 spending plan followed, it was determined that changes are still being made. The treasurer will share it electronically to all Consistory members for approval by the end of May.

The Ministry Team Reports were reviewed by all members prior to the meeting and discussion followed as needed.

God Praise Reports were shared by several members, we reviewed the many praises that were reported in the Celebrating God's Faithfulness on Sunday, May 11, praises offered for the work that has been completed by Pastor Ben, the recent meetings held by all of the Focus Groups and their respective outlines that have been shared, and the many areas that Pastor Kathy is exceeding in her work within Rehoboth.

Ongoing Ministry: Pastor Ben gave a short overview of the work that is done by the Group Coram Deo, this will be placed on the June agenda, as a potential future mission support. He discussed the Visionary Team members and the timeline for the first meeting.

Mike closed the meeting with prayer at 9:00 pm.
