This round will be 5 days. Please pray he tolerates this round with minimal side effects and that the chemo reduces the cancer in his body! 7/2/25: The following is a message from **Pastor Dave McMahon**. *"Thanks to all of you who've expressed concern and prayer. Just to let you know, my surgery date is August 5th. Surgeon will not know what stage the colon cancer is until removal and whether any is in the lymph nodes. 6 to 8 week recovery. That doesn't mean I'll be down all that time. Many can return to work in 4 to 6 weeks. He is not concerned about the spot on the liver. [It doesn't look like what a cancer spot on the liver would look like.] Nor is he concerned about cyst/nodule in the lung. They will take another CT Scan in 12 months. But a good consultation and surgery placement. Bless you all! -Rev. David L. McMahon"* Please continue to pray for Pastor Dave and his entire family during this time.

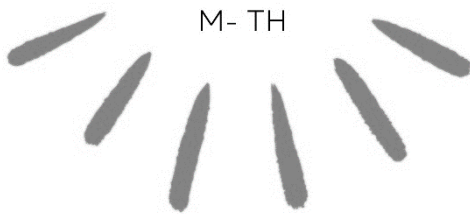
