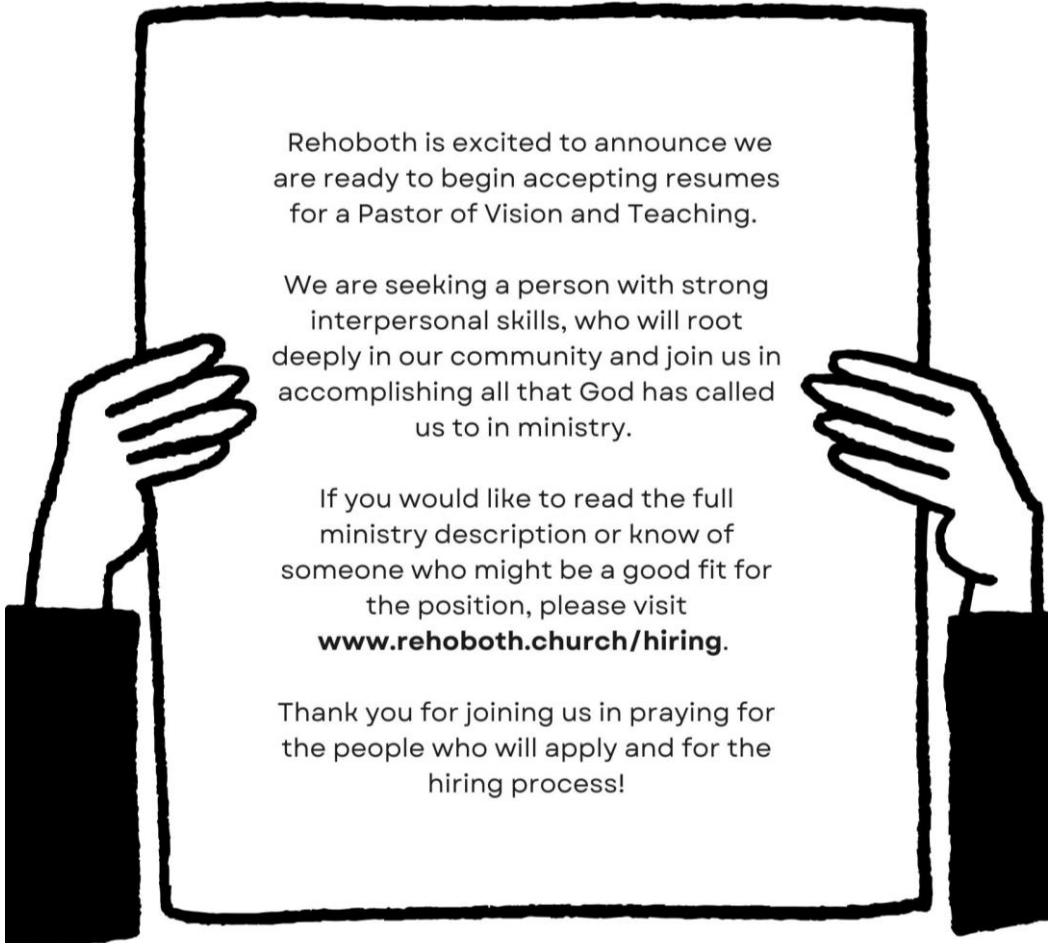
REHOBOTH NOW HIRING
