Dr Murphy is the transplant surgeon, be in specific prayer for him. He's where the final ok is going to come from." **UPDATE 11/19**: PRAISE! Jordan has been approved for a transplant! Please continue to pray for Jordan and Lisa and their entire family!

*About 6 months after they were married, Jordan got an autoimmune disease that attacked his lungs (doctor told him he basically had coalminer lungs) he received a double lung transplant at U of M. This year his lungs have had lots of trouble, he has been on oxygen, a few months ago he was told his body is rejecting his lungs (I'm not sure how that all works but he has steadily been getting worse) U of M no longer will do a second transplant and referred him to Cornell Health and he went through this process there. I just heard that insurance okay the transplant and he has officially been added to the transplant list. He is currently in ICU because his oxygen levels are so low, I'm not sure if this is temporary or if he will remain until he possibly gets the transplant.
