9.	What does 1 John 2:1-2 teach about Jesus as our advocate and atoning sacrifice?
10.	How does Hebrews 9:11-14 describe Jesus as the perfect sacrifice?
11.	How does Colossians 2:9-10 emphasize the fullness of salvation found in Christ alone?
12.	What does 1 Corinthians 3:11 teach about Christ as the only foundation of faith?
