



QUESTIONS FOR HOLY HERESY 3: CHRIST ALONE
(SOLUS CHRISTUS)
MARCH 6, 2025

1. Christ as the Sole Mediator: How does the doctrine of “Solus Christus” shape our understanding of Jesus as the only mediator between God and humanity in a world with diverse religious perspectives?
2. Exclusive vs. Inclusive Salvation: How can Christians faithfully uphold “Solus Christus” in conversations about salvation while engaging with a pluralistic and inclusive culture?
3. Christ’s Sufficiency: What does “Solus Christus” teach us about the sufficiency of Christ’s work on the cross for salvation? How does this address the temptation to rely on personal merit or religious rituals?
4. Christ-Centered Worship: How should the principle of “Solus Christus” influence the way Christians approach worship, preaching, and teaching in the church today?

5. Engaging with Other Religions: How can Christians respectfully and effectively engage with people of other faiths while holding to the truth of “Solus Christus”?
6. Christ and Intercession: In what ways does “Solus Christus” challenge practices or beliefs that rely on saints or other intermediaries for intercession?
7. Personal Relationship with Christ: How does “Solus Christus” emphasize the importance of a personal relationship with Jesus in the life of a believer?
8. Christ in Social Justice: How does the doctrine of “Solus Christus” inform and shape Christian engagement in addressing issues of justice, mercy, and compassion in the world?
9. Christ’s Lordship in All of Life: What are the implications of “Solus Christus” for living under Christ’s lordship in all areas of life—family, work, politics, and culture?
10. Unity in Christ: How does “Solus Christus” encourage unity among Christians of different traditions and denominations, focusing on the centrality of Christ over secondary theological differences?
