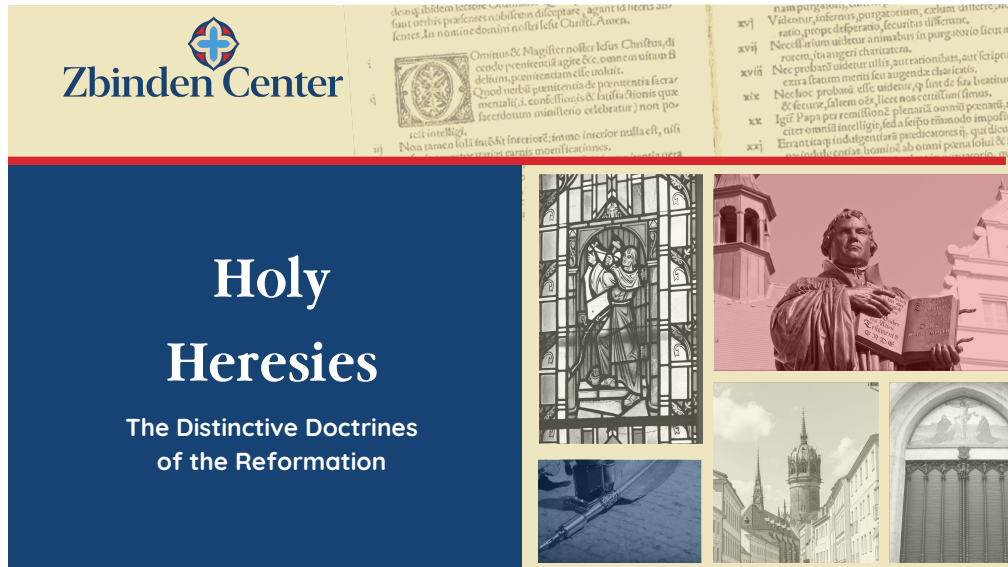




QUESTIONS FOR HOLY HERESY 3: FAITH ALONE

5. How does sola fide uphold the sufficiency of Christ's work for salvation? Romans 5:1
6. What does James 2:14-26 say about the relationship between faith and works? How is this compatible with sola fide?
7. How does Romans 4:2-5 demonstrate that Abraham was justified by faith, not works?
8. What does Galatians 3:10-14 teach about the futility of relying on works of the law for justification?

9. How does Jesus' parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector illustrate justification by faith alone? Luke 18:9-14
10. How does Titus 3:4-7 affirm that justification is a result of God's mercy and grace, not human deeds?
11. How does John 3:16 highlight faith as the means of receiving eternal life?
12. What does Acts 16:30-31 teach about the simplicity of faith in Christ for salvation?
13. How does Hebrews 11:1-6 define faith and its importance in pleasing God?
14. What does Romans 10:9-10 teach about faith's role in confessing and believing for salvation?

15. How does John 6:28-29 reveal that faith is the work God requires for salvation?
16. What does 2 Corinthians 5:7 mean when it says believers walk by faith and not by sight?
17. How does 1 Peter 1:8-9 describe the joy and assurance that come from faith in Christ?
18. What does Galatians 5:6 teach about how true faith expresses itself through love?
19. How does Colossians 2:6-7 encourage believers to remain rooted and built up in faith?
