## **Opening Question/Activity:**

Share about a time when someone showed you genuine love or hospitality. How did it impact you?

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Paul calls for love to be "sincere" (Romans 12:9). What does it mean for love to be sincere rather than hypocritical?
- 2. Why do you think Paul connects love with rejecting evil? How can we actively cling to what is good in our daily lives?
- 3. Romans 12:10 encourages believers to be devoted to one another in love. What are some practical ways we can show deep commitment to fellow believers?
- 4. What does it look like to "outdo one another in showing honor"? How can we practice this in our church and personal relationships?
- 5. Paul urges us to "never be lacking in zeal." How do we keep our spiritual passion alive, even during difficult seasons?
- 6. When has meeting another believer's needs been inconvenient? Explain why it was inconvenient?
- 7. What does the tension of pleasing people and pleasing God look like in your life?
- 8. Hospitality goes beyond inviting someone over—it's about making people feel seen and valued. How can we live this out in everyday life?
- 9. Which part of this passage do you feel God is calling you to grow in the most? How can you take practical steps this week?

## **Challenge for the Week:**

As a group, brainstorm ways to meet real needs for the right reason in the right way with fellow believers in the weeks ahead. What specific action could you take?
