# **Discussion Guide**

### **Scripture:**

John 14:15-26

### **Opening Activity:**

What's one time in your spiritual life where something in Scripture suddenly made sense to you—a moment when the truth "clicked"? Share what was revealed and how it changed your perspective.

## **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. Read John 14:15. How does loving Jesus relate to keeping His commands?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus immediately follows that command with the promise of the Holy Spirit in verses 16-17?
- 3. Jesus calls the Holy Spirit our "Helper" or "Advocate." What does this mean practically in your daily walk with God?
- 4. How is the Holy Spirit like the magnifying glass in the sermon illustration? What happens when we read the Bible without His help?
- 5. Read verse 21. What does this verse say about obedience and God revealing Himself to us?
- 6. According to verse 26, what is the Spirit's role in teaching and reminding us of Jesus' words?
- 7. Why is it important to understand the Holy Spirit as "another of the same kind" as Jesus (v. 16)? How does this affect our confidence in following Him?
- 8. What lies does the enemy (the accuser) try to convince us of when we fail to keep God's commands?
- 9. How does knowing the Spirit dwells in you (v. 17) give you confidence and comfort?
- 10. What steps can you take this week to invite the Holy Spirit into your time in God's Word?

### **Challenge:**

Before reading Scripture each day this week, pray: "Holy Spirit, I need You. Help me understand, obey, and love Your Word today." Then:

- Journal one thing the Spirit reveals in you each day in the Word.
- Reflect on how that insight helps you keep one of Jesus' commands.
- Share what stood out to you with someone in your group.
