Opening Activity:

Have you ever had a moment when something finally "clicked"—about God, yourself or life—and you saw things differently?

Read:

1 Corinthians 2:1-16 1 Corinthians 1:30 Ephesians 1:9-11 Galatians 1:11-12 Philippians 3:7-11 Psalm 139: 23-24 Romans 10:9-10 John 14:26

Discussion Questions:

- 1. In your own walk, how have you sensed God revealing something you couldn't have understood on your own?
- 2. What helps you stay open to the Holy Spirit's guidance in your daily decisions?
- 3. When have you realized that spiritual truths made sense to you only after following Jesus?
- 4. What is one area of your thinking you need God to reshape toward Christlikeness?
- 5. How do you distinguish God's wisdom from the world's wisdom in your life choices?
- 6. When has God revealed something about Himself or about you that changed the way you lived?
- 7. Where are you currently frustrated that you "don't understand" something—and what would it look like to ask God to reveal instead of just trying harder?
- 8. How do you personally balance using your mind (study, reason) with depending on the Spirit's revelation?
- 9. What might God want to reveal in our group right now—about calling, sin, next steps, or people He's drawing to Himself?

Challenge for the Week:

Choose a person who has been on your mind—someone you'd rejoice to see pursue the Lord—and initiate one meaningful conversation with them this week. Ask how they're doing, listen with care, and trust the Holy Spirit to guide whatever comes next.
