Opening Activity:

Have you ever experienced what felt like a “divine meeting”—a moment where you walked away thinking, “that wasn’t random”? Briefly share what happened and why it stuck with you.

Read:

Genesis 14:17-24

Hebrews 7:23-27

Hebrews 10:19-25

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Genesis 14:18-20. Abram gives after being reminded God gave him victory. Where has God clearly provided for you, and how did that shape your response?
2. Read Genesis 14:21-23. Abram refuses Sodom’s reward so God alone gets the glory. When are you tempted to secure credit, control, or recognition instead of trusting God?
3. Read Hebrews 7:23-27. Jesus’ sacrifice was once and for all. Do you live like your forgiveness is complete, or do you still try to earn it? Where does that show up?
4. Read Hebrews 7:27. Jesus had no sin to atone for. Why does that matter for your confidence in Him—and your honesty about your own sin?
5. Read Hebrews 10:19-22. We can boldly enter God’s presence. Do you approach God boldly, cautiously, or distantly? What shaped that posture?
6. Grace precedes gratitude and results in giving back. When have you given from gratitude instead of obligation? What was different internally?
7. Where are you subtly trying to earn God’s favor instead of living from it?
8. What “Sodom-like” influences compete with your loyalty to God right now?
9. How does Jesus’ finished work challenge the way you give—financially, relationally, or spiritually?
10. If someone observed your life this week, would they see gratitude or pressure driving your generosity? What needs to change?

Challenge for the Week:

Choose one intentional act of giving this week that flows from gratitude for Christ’s finished work—not pressure or guilt. Tell someone in your group what you plan to do, and next week briefly share what changed in your heart as you gave.
