- How does Romans 8:28 apply to this question?
- What does this passage teach about holding a grudge?
- What does it teach about blessing those who curse you?
- If God is at work in the evil done to us, why doesn't that make God evil?
- If God is at work in the evil done to us, why doesn't that excuse the evil-doer?
