Vv.3-31 In the six creation days, God arranges what he created. How and why does he form the world on Days 1-3? How and why does he fill the world on Days 4-6?

- What repeated phrases and/or patterns do you observe?
- Why do you think the Bible tells us that God created, but does not tell us exactly how he created?

## APPLICATION.

- This passage demonstrates the significance of God's spoken word and his sovereign power. How does this relate to your personal experience with God?
- According to Romans 1:20-23, what should be our response to the revelation of God in his creation?
- When and how does creation prompt you to worship?
- Are there any dangers or extremes you should be aware of when it comes to appreciating creation? If so, what do you think they are?

- Since Genesis 1 presents the all-powerful Creator who brings beauty out of chaos, what significance does that have for your life today?
- What does this creation passage teach about the value and significance of humans, and how should this inform your treatment of yourself and other people?
- How should this passage inform the way you treat the earth and its creatures?
- Fact: What is a key truth that you understood from this passage?
- React: What did you feel?
- Act: What one thing could you do to apply this Scripture?
