



Joshua 7:1 - 9:27



Guardrails:

1. Broaden to the whole counsel of Scripture
2. Allow for biblical tension
3. Maintain humility

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord.

For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Isaiah 55:8-9


→ ^dWhat timeless truth stood out to you? Spend time at your table praising the Lord for these truths.
