SERMON RECAP

Provoking one another toward love and good works is helping each other live victorious life in Christ.

THE LEAD IN

- Think about a few times that you have been provoked in your life. What or who provoked you? Was it helpful or harmful provocation? What was your response?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Hebrews 10:19-27. The beginning verses give reason to the “why” behind our call as disciples. What should our response be to what Christ has done for us?
- What does this text tell us about how holding unwaveringly to the hope of Christ builds community between one another? What are we called to provoke each other towards?

GOING DEEPER

- Can you think of a time when someone challenged or provoked you in a way that strengthened your faith? What was your response and how did it impact your walk with the Lord and one another?
- Who is the Lord putting on your heart that you could provoke towards love and good deeds? Please make sure to consider your motivations for provoking, to do so in love rather than in judgement.

PRAYER

- Pray Hebrews 12:1b-2a together, desiring to set your eyes on Christ as you run the Christian life with perseverance with Jesus as the goal.
