LIVING ON MISSION TOGETHER | APRIL 6, 2025

SERMON RECAP

If the goal of our groups is community, comfortable community, we will never be on mission with one another. However, if our purpose is to be on mission together, we'll almost always experience community in the process.

THE LEAD IN

- Through this sermon series on the *One Another*s, we've looked at love one another, be hospitable to one another, live at peace with one another, care for one another, confess your sins to one another, encourage one another, and don't give up meeting with one another. Did one in particular stand out to you? Why?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Philippians 1:3-5 and 2 Corinthians 5:17-20. How do you see one anothering in these passages? Why does Paul encourage partnership and togetherness in his urging towards gospel proclamation?
- In Luke 10, Jesus sends out his followers on mission in pairs. Read verses 1-7 and 17-24. Why do you think He sent them out in pairs? What were the results when they returned?

GOING DEEPER

- Re-read the sermon recap above. How do you feel about that statement? Agree? Disagree? Why?
- Matt urged us to consider a few questions: Who are you praying for that doesn't know Christ? Who is close to you that you can partner with? Who has a similar passion? How can you create space together to introduce others to Christ?

PRAYER

- Pray for boldness together to be on mission for Christ as ambassadors. Pray for those who you might reach with the gospel together.
