Use these questions in your Life Group gatherings or for further discussion as a family.

THE TESTIMONY OF GOD | MARCH 1, 2026

SERMON RECAP

God has unequivocally and undeniably declared that eternal life is found, and only found, in Jesus Christ.

THE LEAD IN

- Growing up, whose opinion or testimony did you trust the most? What made them most credible to you?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read 1 John 5:6-12. John speaks to three testimonies: the Spirit, the water, and the blood. What do each of the testimonies signify and what does each testify about Jesus?
- Verses 9 and 10 give two possible responses to the testimonies: believing what God testifies about who Jesus is or rejecting God's testimony. What is God's testimony about who Jesus is? (*Hint: go back to verses 7 and 8*).

GOING DEEPER

- What is the life in the Son that this passage tells us is given to us by God? How have you experienced this life as you've walked with Jesus? How is it different than what voices in the world around us try to tell us offer life – health, wealth, success, comfort, etc.?
- Tom said, "Through Jesus, we don't just receive eternal pardon. We don't receive eternal boredom. Or eternal small talk. Or eternal busywork. Through Jesus we receive eternal life, which is life to the full. Life in Jesus is delight, it's joy, it's satisfaction and meaning. It's wholeness in His presence." Respond to this statement and discuss as a group.

PRAYER

- As you pray, praise God for the fullness of life that He has given to us through His Son!
