SERMON RECAP

Jesus' name is the reason for evangelism. We can't live for our own name and His at the same time. Above all, we live to proclaim the story of Jesus.

THE LEAD IN

- Who is someone who has shown you great hospitality? What do you think was their motivation?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read 3 John in its entirety. John thanks and affirms Gaius for his hospitality to the brothers and sisters who have come through “for the sake of the Name.” What does it mean to go out for the sake of the Name?
- Why does John call out Diotrephes? What damage is he causing and whose name is he seeking to make great? Contrast Diotrephes with Jesus’ teaching in Mark 10:43-45 about greatness in the Kingdom.

GOING DEEPER

- Whose name are you living for, primarily? Consider taking a few minutes as a group quietly to allow for self-reflection then have an honest discussion with each other about where you each are at. In what areas of daily life do elevate your name over Jesus’?
- There are two roles in evangelistic mission – senders and goers. Which role are you in right now? Who in your Oikos needs to hear the name of Jesus from you? Who might God be calling you to help send?

PRAYER

- Ask God to reveal whose name you are truly living for. Pray for boldness to Proclaim Jesus and for anyone in your Oikos who needs to hear His name.
