BEHOLDING GLORY | MARCH 29, 2026

SERMON RECAP

Beholding the glory of Jesus, His authority over death and power to give life, moves us to worship Him and draw others to Him.

THE LEAD IN

- Share a story of when you were an eyewitness to something so remarkable that you had to tell someone about it immediately. What happened? Who did you tell?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read John 11:1-12:12. This is a long section, take the time to read it aloud together. The crowd was full of energy only days after Jesus' resurrection of Lazarus. What does the crowd's response to Jesus reveal about what they believed about Him?
- Go back to the story of Jesus' interactions with Mary and Martha, before raising Lazarus. How did Jesus' delay in raising Lazarus reveal God's glory and show who Jesus is?

GOING DEEPER

- Have you beheld the glory of who Jesus is? Do you approach Him with a fear of death? Do you worship Him or try to impress Him and others?
- Part of the Westminster Confession of Faith says, "The chief end of man is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever." What does it look like for you to enjoy God each day, not just waiting for Heaven? How does that show those around you the glory of God?

PRAYER

- Behold His glory! Pray prayers of praise and thanksgiving for His power and authority as you worship Him.
