WAITING WITH THE LORD | APRIL 19, 2026

SERMON RECAP

God is with us in the ordinary, with us through speech, and with us by grace.

THE LEAD IN

- What is something you waited a long time for, or maybe are still waiting for? What was, or is, that season like?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Genesis 15:1-6. God comes to Abram “after this.” There were clearly years of waiting—waiting while holding onto an unfulfilled promise. What do you notice about how God meets Abram and how Abram responds?
- What phrase is repeated in this text and what does it tell us about how God makes Himself known to His people? How do Amos 8:11-12, John 6:68, Hebrews 1:1-2, and 2 Peter 1:20-21 support this?

GOING DEEPER

- God gave Abram some wild promises that he didn’t deserve. Abram believed Him and it was credited to him as righteousness. Abram didn’t have a plan, any power, or understanding. He waited and believed. What does it look like for you to trust God’s words in a season when you’re still waiting?
- God shows up for Abram, takes Him outside to see the grandeur of the stars, and renews His promise to Abram. How has God shown up to you in seasons of doubt, anxiety, uncertainty, and loss? How did it build and encourage your faith?

PRAYER

- Pray for belief in seasons of waiting. Ask God to give you faith to trust that He is enough even when you can’t see what lies ahead.
