IN AWE AND TREMBLING OF A HOLY GOD | APRIL 26, 2026

SERMON RECAP

God is eternally holy which causes the human response of awe and trembling. Yet He calls us to draw near to Him with confidence.

THE LEAD IN

- Have you ever been in the presence of someone powerful or famous that made you suddenly aware of yourself? Why? What was that like?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Exodus 3:1-15. God says three things to Moses before sending him to free His people: don't come any closer, take off your shoes, and I am the God of your ancestors. What do each of these statements tell us about who God is?
- Hebrews 10:19-25 gives us the reason why we can have confidence to come into the presence of God – the blood of Christ. What should our response be to the holiness of God?

GOING DEEPER

- We often sit in awe of famous or popular people, entertainment, and sports, but we don't make it a regular practice to sit in awe of God. How would a fresh sense of God's holiness change the way you worship, pray, and live daily life for Him? Keep Hebrews 10 in mind.
- Nick gave us three takeaways from the life of Moses: 1) there is a Holy God who is unchanging, unfathomably pure, and perfect, 2) we should be aware and trembling of His greatness and purity, 3) we should pursue and remain in His presence. How can each of these truths affect your life, and through you, your Oikos?

PRAYER

- Lift up praise, thanksgiving, and requests to God in awe of who He is and with confidence in the good news of the gospel.
