THE LORD IS MY BANNER | MAY 17, 2026

SERMON RECAP

When the Lord is our Banner, the victory is sure – won not by our strength, but by dependence on God.

THE LEAD IN

- Share about a time when you felt way in over your head and someone jumped in to help you. What did they do to support you? How did the situation play out?

GETTING INTO THE TEXT

- Read Exodus 17:8-16. Moses, Aaron, Hur, and Joshua are each significant in this passage. They depend on each other and the Lord. Where do you see that dependence on each other? On the Lord?
- Ephesians 6:10-18 tells us how to engage in the battle, in full dependence on the Lord. Who is the war between? How does the Spirit equip us for the war that wages around us?

GOING DEEPER

- Moses builds an altar and calls it “The Lord is My Banner,” a rallying point that declares Who gets the glory. In your life, in the battles you face, and the joys you celebrate, who gets the glory? How do you live under God’s banner?
- What does it look like for you to fight with both staff and sword, prayer and God’s Word? When do you feel weak or attacked and how do you use prayer and God’s Word in those times?

PRAYER

- Praying as a group is a beautiful way to engage in dependence on the Lord together as you each face battles each day. Pray specifically for each other in those areas of weakness shared.
